Introduction

Clinical lecturers play a crucial role in bridging the gap between theoretical medical education delivered on campus and practical clinical training conducted during clinical rotations.

Many healthcare professionals possess strong clinical expertise but have had limited formal training in clinical teaching methodology. *This short online course is designed to strengthen the pedagogical skills required to effectively guide medical students through both academic and clinical learning.*

The course provides practical strategies for teaching in the classroom, supervising clinical rotations, *facilitating clinical reasoning, and evaluating student performance.*

Course Content

- Principles of medical education and adult learning
- Effective teaching strategies for clinical lecturers
- Structuring lectures and interactive learning sessions
- Teaching during clinical rotations and bedside learning
- Guiding students in history taking and physical examination.
- Promoting clinical reasoning and diagnostic thinking
- Student assessment and constructive feedback
- Organizing structured clinical teaching sessions
